MODULE AIMS

The module is aimed at students interested in starting their own business or in joining an existing small business with a view to helping it expand.

Firstly it considers key enterprise skills including opportunity spotting, creative thinking and problem solving, personal motivation, the entrepreneurial mind-set and attitude; and introduces the vital components for self employment success.

Secondly the module provides a vehicle to enable students to integrate and relate the theories in the core business functions and to apply them in the process of new venture creation by the development of a business plan.
