Portfolio development will typically focus upon:

- ✓ Analysing situations which have developed skills and enhanced employability
- ✓ Evaluating interactions with managers, colleagues, and subordinates
- ✓ Discussing consequences of actions and identify ways in which improvement or change can be made
- ✓ Discussing personal development needs
- ✓ Providing sufficient evidence to demonstrate capabilities
- ✓ Audit skills and create an action plan
- ✓ Contingency Planning
- ✓ Critical reflective analysis of work-based learning which applies theoretical models from across the student's programme of study to the real-world environment
