## Project Objectives, Description and Impact (300 words max)

This project designed and implemented a foundational setting through which we kick start research and activities on human rights education. The project used this tool to develop a human rights culture amongst young people and prompt key stakeholders to use this tool. As such, the project (i) worked with young people (local young people, migrants, refugees, ethnic minorities, sexual minorities) for purposes of endowing them with the knowledge, skills and attitudes to be active citizens who know and uphold their rights and the rights of others (ii) conducted an awareness raising session for stakeholders such as community leaders, civil society staff, formal and non-formal educators on HRE and how to use this tool with their beneficiaries and communities. In the Cypriot setting, the activities were of a bi-communal nature, thereby using HRE to facilitate the peace making process.
