Project Objectives, Description and Impact (300 words max)

SHERPA is an interdisciplinary EU-funded project, which investigates, analyses and synthesises our understanding of the ways AI and big data analytics impact ethics and human rights. Started in May 2018, the SHERPA consortium has 11 partners from six European countries (representing academia, industry, civil society, standards bodies, ethics committees, art).

In dialogue with stakeholders, the project plans to develop novel ways of understanding SIS challenges, evaluate with stakeholders, and advocate the most desirable and sustainable solutions including technical and regulatory options (e.g., terms of reference for a regulator), as well as promote and implement the most promising solutions through targeted dissemination and communication activities.
